

APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- (1) Payment of \$250 U.S. dollars (\$200 tuition deposit, \$50 nonrefundable application fee) in the form of a check (draw-able on U.S. funds), postal money order, or travelers' checks-made out to Georgetown University. Cash or credit cards not accepted.
- (2) A copy of a diploma or transcript **in English** showing proof of secondary school completion or of university studies beyond secondary school. All students must be at least 17 years of age and have completed high school.
- (3) A **copy** of your passport and a passport-size photograph of yourself.
- (4) Evidence of financial support if requesting I-20.

U.S. VISA INFORMATION

An F-1 Student Visa is required for full-time study in the U.S. Full-time study is not allowed on a B-1/B-2 Tourist Visa, an F-2 Visa or a visa waiver. To apply for an F-1 Student Visa, you will need a Form I-20 (Certificate of Eligibility for F-1 Visa). The EFL Program issues the Form I-20 to students who meet admission requirements and provide evidence of sufficient financial support. Take the Form I-20 to the U.S. Embassy or Consulate in your country to apply for the F-1 Student Visa. **IMPORTANT: All first-time F-1 visa applicants are required to pay a SEVIS fee before applying for an F-1 Visa.** For more information, visit the EFL website.

FORM I-20 APPLICATION

According to U.S. Department of Homeland Security regulations, Georgetown University is required to obtain certification that applicants have financial resources which will adequately provide for their expenses. To receive an I-20, you must complete this application and include an original bank statement or letter of sponsorship in English which shows proof of sufficient funding to cover tuition and estimated personal expenses while you are in the U.S. (the amount available must be specified in U.S. dollars). Financial evidence must show the total support required for each program:

If someone other than you is providing financial support, the statement must come from that person’s bank.

If you will be sponsored by a company, foundation or government agency, please attach a letter from the sponsor listing the costs and expenses the sponsor will pay. The letter must be dated and written on official letterhead.
